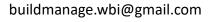

#### 2. Property description

The scope of this inspection is carried out in accordance with NZS 4306:2005 The dwelling LIM report and/or property information file was not reviewed, and we recommend this is checked to ensure what is recorded on the property file matches what is constructed on site.

Dwelling was built in the 1950s (Est) and well presented. The overall condition of the dwelling is in very good condition for its age and in line with any other dwelling of the same age that's been maintained.

Single level dwelling with basement area and outdoor shed. 3x Bedrooms (plus extra space for bedroom in basement), 2x Bathrooms, 2x Toilets. Flowing lounge, dinning and kitchen. Situated on a semi flat section out front, slopping to back. Dwelling is approx 1km to the nearest convenience store. No mould visible, and most moisture meter readings were in a reasonable range expect in bedroom 2, the room next to laundry and downstairs bar area had very high moisture reading indicating dampness and further investigation recommended.

Cladding is timber weather board and block with single glazed aluminium window inserts with vinyl, wood, and tile flooring. The hip and valley roof consists of decramastic tiles. Spouting and down pipes are PVC. External cladding is in good condition for its age.

Maintaining your home helps increase its value and lifespan, ensuring the structure continues to perform. Planned preventative maintenance is a proven method of identifying and preventing minor maintenance issues before they escalate into major problems that could cost you more in the long run.

#### 3. Noted in inspection

NB: Any dwelling constructed prior to 1996 and where Claddings/Soffits have used fibrolite, this is likely to contain asbestos, so care is needed when maintenance is conducted

- Westside of the house the roof spouting has leaky junction
- Paint is bubbling in soffit in a couple of areas as per photos
- The decramastic roof tiles are due for maintenance (recoating)
- Roof has double cladding with iron under the tiles
- Deck handrail does not comply to today's building standards due to its low height, however it would have complied at the time if consented
- Front door needs a shaving, so it closes nicely
- Walls have minor cracks in the gib (or alike) throughout due to possible movement over the years.
- Ceiling has minor cracks in the fibrous plaster throughout due to possible movement over the years and this will be too old to paint as the paint will not stick.

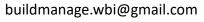

- For best practice the windows up high ie dining, office & bathroom need window stays so children cannot climb out and would not comply with today's current building standards.
- French doors into kitchen cannot close due and require maintenance to achieve this.
- Bedroom 2 has a high moisture meter reading to the right had side. Further investigation recommended
- Joinery windows in ensuite & main bathroom are having trouble opening/closing
- Hallway back door and hall door need shaving, so they close nicely
- Roof space has no building paper which is typical of this age home
- Roof structure appears sound
- Stairs going down to laundry do not comply, due to tread depth and this is a hazard, also more safety railing required
- Room off laundry with tiled floor and aluminium joinery, has damaged linings and high moisture meter reading
- Bar area has high moisture readings and ranch slider has rotting wood bottom right hand side.
- Sub floor structure appears sound and in keeping with its age also no insulation
- Decorative Plywood enclosure for firewood is rotting in parts

**Multi-Unit Property (ies).** Any property that accommodates more than one residential dwelling unit and where the owners have collective obligations. Multi-unit properties will usually be owned under a body corporate, cross lease or company title where the relevant legislation along with the body corporate rules and unit plan, memorandum of lease and flat plan or constitution and occupation agreement define the areas of individual and collective responsibility.
